Air Pacific Announces New Check-in Policy

Effective 15 Sep 2010

Air Pacific is committed to on-time departures. We recommend that you always allow ample time for check-in. During certain times of the year (holidays and peak travel periods), we ask that you allow additional time.

As part of its efforts to ensure on-time flights and better service delivery, Fiji's national carrier Air Pacific and its regional subsidiary Pacific Sun will be implementing new check-in times for all customers beginning on the 15th of September, 2010. Check-ins for Air Pacific will no longer be open for three hours as has been the case previously. From September 15, international passengers will be able to begin check-in 3 hours prior to departure, and are **required to check-in no later than one (1) hour before departure**. This applies to all international passengers.

International travel on Air Pacific flights:

Please check-in 3 hours prior to your flight. Check-in for International flights closes 1 hour prior to departure. This includes departures from all International Gateway cities (LAX, SYD, AKL, etc.) as well as Nadi & Nausori international airports in Fiji, Apia, Christmas Island, Funafuti, Honiara, Nuku'alofa, Port Vila and Tarawa. **Failure to check-in prior to the flight closure time may result in you being denied boarding and forfeiting all monies paid.** Requirements for international baggage can be viewed [here](#).

Domestic travel on Pacific Sun flights:

Domestic travel (within Fiji), please arrive at least 90 minutes before your flight. Check-in for Domestic flights closes 30 minutes prior to departure. **Failure to check-in prior to the flight closure time may result in you being denied boarding and forfeiting all monies paid.** Requirements for domestic baggage can be viewed [here](#).

Security and immigrations check points require additional time after check-in, so please continue through this stage and to the gate immediately following check-in.

Passengers arriving at the airport and attempting to check in less than one hour before scheduled international departures or 30 minutes before domestic departures will not be permitted to board. They will, however, be allowed to rebook their ticket on a subsequent flight for a fee. Operating hours for all Air Pacific check-in counters will remain the same, with check-in counters opened to customers three hours before departure.
